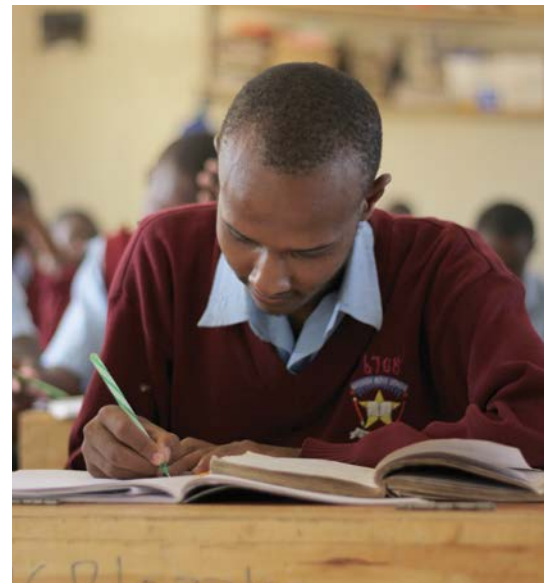

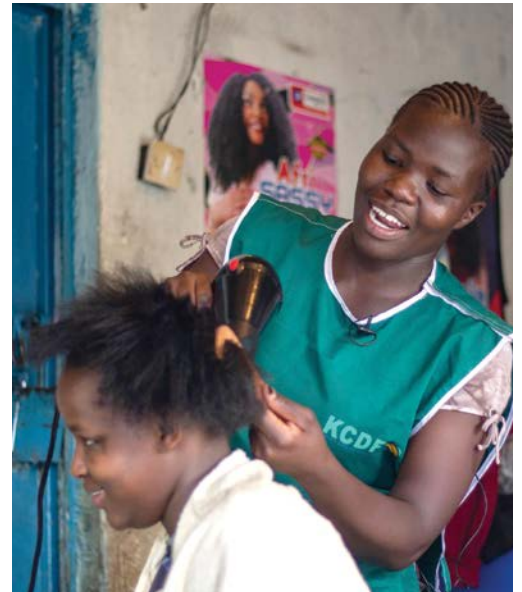
KCDF Livelihoods Programme Impact
